- ➤ The Study on Readiness of the Mediterranean Region to Respond to Marine Pollution Incidents Involving Low-Sulphur and Alternative Fuels (<u>The Study</u>)
- ➤ Revised Part II: Basic Information on Dispersants and their Application of the Guidelines for the Use of Dispersants for Combating Oil Pollution at Sea in the Mediterranean 2011 (The Guidelines)

This webinar aims:

- to promote the continuous practice of raising awareness about such deliverables, a step forward to their use/implementation.
- it also forms part of this strategic objective of the Study, specifically focusing on conducting regional training workshops and exercises.









THE STUDY ON READINESS OF THE MEDITERRANEAN REGION TO RESPOND TO MARINE POLLUTION INCIDENTS INVOLVING LSF AND AF

A set of targeted recommendations aimed at strengthening the Mediterranean region's ability to respond to pollution incidents, with a specific focus on those involving LSF and AF.

- Recommendations are organized into four key Strategic Objectives (SOs)
 - Policy and regulatory improvements (SO1)
 - Capacity building and training (SO2)
 - · Enhancing response mechanisms (SO3)
 - Strengthening stakeholder engagement and collaboration (SO4)

- Roadmap establishes the foundation for the subsequent action plan, which operationalizes the Sos
 - Lay the foundation for preparedness by addressing regulatory and operational gaps in the short term.
 - Strengthen regional coordination and capacity through mid-term actions that enhance infrastructure, technology, and collaboration.

• Achieve long-term sustainability and resilience by fully integrating innovation, harmonizing frameworks, and

institutionalizing best.
