# PROPOSED PROGRAMME OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE BIENNIUM 2008/2009

# Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The Secretariat prepared a draft programme of activities for the biennium 2008/2009 to be financed by the Mediterranean Trust Fund (MTF). The proposed programme of activities was developed with a view to facilitating the effective implementation of the 2002 Protocol Concerning Cooperation in Preventing Pollution from Ships and, in Cases of Emergency, Combating Pollution of the Mediterranean Sea ("Prevention and Emergency" Protocol), which was adopted on the 25 January 2002 and entered into force on 17 March 2004, taking into consideration the main following elements:
  - a) the Regional Strategy for Prevention of and Response to Marine Pollution from Ships, approved by the fourteenth Ordinary Meeting of the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention (Portoroz, Slovenia, 8-11 November 2005), and its specific objectives;
  - b) the activities and projects (including the EU-funded MEDA project on Euromed Cooperation on Maritime Safety and Prevention of Pollution from Ships SAFEMED) carried out or being implemented during the biennium 2006/2007, in order to ensure any necessary continuity between these activities and those planned for the biennium 2008/2009.
- 2. The general orientations of the Centre for the biennium 2008/2009 are reflected in three singled out general objectives, namely:
  - Promoting the ratification, transposition, implementation and enforcement of international regulations to prevent, reduce and control pollution of the marine environment from ships in the Mediterranean region (Objective I);
  - Ensuring prompt and efficient response to marine pollution incidents in the Mediterranean region (Objective II); and
  - Strengthening synergy and improving exchange of information and expertise within and outside the Mediterranean region (Objective III).

- 3. Under each general objective, specific goals have been set on the basis of identified needs. The said goals are expected to be reached by implementing the proposed activities.
- 4. The proposed programme of activities for the biennium 2008/2009 appears as an **Annex** to the present document.
- 5. In addition to the activities financed by the MTF, it should be noted that some additional activities, financed completely or partly by various external sources, could also be implemented during the biennium 2008/2009.
- 6. These include in particular:
  - activities (not yet identified) financed by the Integrated Technical Cooperation Programme (ITCP) of the International Maritime Organisation (IMO);
  - activities to be implemented under the IMO's GEF-funded project "Building Partnership to Assist Developing Countries to Reduce the Transfer of Harmful Aquatic Organisms in Ships' Ballast Water (GloBallast Partnerships) provided that the PDF B proposal is approved by the Global Environment Facility (GEF) Council;
  - activities financed by possible voluntary contributions of individual Contracting Parties to the REMPEC's budget for the biennium 2008/2009.
- 7. Moreover, should opportunities arise from new developments and/or partnerships, activities, that do not appear under the proposed programme, might have to be initiated or carried out under the biennium 2008-2009, if they appear to be in line with the Strategy.
- 8. On the basis of the views expressed by the present Meeting, REMPEC will present the estimated budget allocations for the proposed activities to be proposed to the next Meeting of MAP Focal Points, scheduled for October 2007, prior to their submission for approval to the Fifteenth Ordinary Meeting of the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention, scheduled for December 2007. It is however assumed that the total amount to be allocated to the REMPEC budget for the biennium 2008/2009 will not vary from the budget approved by the Contracting Parties for the biennium 2006/2007 at their Fourteenth Ordinary (UNEP(DEC)/MED IG.16/13, Annex IV).

The Meeting of Focal Points is invited to review discuss and agree upon the programme of activities for 2008/2009 biennium prepared by the Secretariat, which will be presented to the forthcoming Meeting of MAP Focal Points and subsequently submitted for approval to the Contracting Parties at their Fifteenth Ordinary Meeting.
