Introduction

- The Fourth Meeting of the Mediterranean Network of Law Enforcement Officials relating to the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (MARPOL) within the framework of the Convention for the Protection of the Marine Environment and the Coastal Region of the Mediterranean ("the Barcelona Convention") (MENELAS), hereinafter referred to as the Meeting, is being convened remotely from 21 to 22 April 2021, pursuant to the Programme of Work and Budget for 2020-2021 of the Mediterranean Action Plan (MAP) of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), also referred to as UNEP/MAP, adopted by the Twenty-first Ordinary Meeting of the Contracting Parties to the Barcelona Convention and its Protocols (Naples, Italy, 2-5 December 2019) (UNEP/MED IG.24/22).
- 2 The principal objectives of the Meeting are:
 - .1 to examine the implementation of the MENELAS Programme of Activities for the period 2020-2021, and to discuss about cooperation with other regional and international organisations; and
 - .2 to discuss and agree on the items to be included in the MENELAS Programme of Activities for the period 2022-2023 and elect the chair of the network for the said period.
- 3 All MENELAS Designated Representatives were invited to nominate jointly and, in consultation with the REMPEC Prevention Focal Points, their representatives in the Meeting. The invitation to participate in the Meeting was also extended to observers from relevant regional and international organisations, the activities of which are relevant to the objectives of the Meeting.

In order to assist the Meeting in its work, the Secretariat prepared the following annotations to the proposed provisional agenda of the Meeting.

Opening of the Meeting

The Meeting will open on Wednesday, 21 April 2021 at 0900 hours and is expected to close on Thursday, 22 April 2021 at 1530 hours¹.

Rules of Procedure

The Rules of procedure for Meetings and Conferences of the Contracting Parties to the Convention for the Protection of the Mediterranean Sea against Pollution and its related Protocols (UNEP/IG.43/6, Annex XI) shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the deliberations of this Meeting.

Election of Officers

7 The Meeting will be invited to elect a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson, and a Rapporteur.

Working Languages

8 The working languages of the Meeting will be English and French. Simultaneous English/French/English interpretation will be provided during the Meeting. All working documents will be available in both official languages of the Centre, i.e. in English and in French. Information documents will be available in their original language unless a translation is provided in the second working language.

- Participants will be encouraged to briefly present their views on the establishment of a MENELAS database on illicit ship pollution discharges in the Mediterranean.

 - .1 the Operational Guidelines on the Provision of Reception Facilities in Ports and the Delivery of Ship-Generated Wastes in the Mediterranean, as set out in Annex III to the said decision; and
 - .2 the Guidance Document to Determine the Application of Charges at Reasonable Costs for the Use of Port Reception Facilities or, when Applicable, Application of the No-Special-Fee System, in the Mediterranean, as set out in Annex IV to the said decision.
- Participants will be encouraged to briefly present their views on measures to charge reasonable costs for the use of port reception facilities or, when applicable, apply a No-Special-Fee system.
- The Meeting will be invited to take note of the information provided as well as to comment, as deemed appropriate.

Agenda Item 8 Cooperation with other regional and international organisations
